The Vienna Institute for International Economic Studies ([www.wiiw.ac.at](http://www.wiiw.ac.at)) is part of a consortium which was invited by the European Commission to submit a project proposal for the EU tender 'EU Support to the Economic Policy Planning Unit in BiH' (EPPU). The aim of this project is to strengthen the BiH government's capacity to devise and implement economic policies and to generate concepts and reform ideas for the government's use in its reform efforts.

## PROFILES

**1. INTERNATIONAL LONG-TERM EXPERT (ILTE)** who will work with, coach, mentor, train and build the institutional capacity of the EPPU and who will develop the work and working methods of the EPPU. He/She will act as Team Leader, thus represent the project consortium in BiH and be responsible for operational aspects of the project implementation.

Formal requirements:

- legal residence outside BiH,
- citizenship of an eligible CARDS-country (other than BiH)
- be located in Sarajevo for 20 months

Qualifications and skills:

- postgraduate degree in economics,
- demonstrated analytical skills,
- well-developed interpersonal skills as well as skills in mediation
- excellent communications skills and ability to lead a team in a multi-cultural environment,
- knowledge of the SA process
- preferably good command of local language

General professional experience:

- a minimum of 15 years of professional experience, preferably in economic policy institutions of national governments, independent research institutions, universities and/or financial institutions,
- minimum 5 years professional management experience

Specific professional experience

- preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate sizeable experience in the field of trade policy
- preference will be given to candidates who were engaged in building the capacity of economic policy institutions

**2. NATIONAL LONG-TERM EXPERT (NLTE)** who will assist the ILTE in building the capacity of the EPPU

Formal requirements:

- being located in Sarajevo for 23 months

Qualifications and skills:

- a relevant post-graduate degree, preferably in economics
- demonstrated analytical skills
- well-developed interpersonal skills as well as skills in mediation
- knowledge of the SA process
- preferably good command of local language

General professional experience:

- a minimum of 15 years of professional experience, preferably in economic policy institutions of national governments, independent research institutions, universities and/or financial institutions

Specific professional experience:

- preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate sizeable experience in econometrics

Deadline for the submission of CVs: **15 July 2004**

In addition to these two key experts, we'll have to find additional long-term experts and short-term experts in a later stage. They shall have a relevant University degree and a minimum of 5 years professional working experience in the field of economic policy advise and/or analysis.
