The Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich is seeking to fill a

Professorship (W2) in European Integration and Political Economy with emphasis on Eastern Europe

This Chair will be held in connection with the interdisciplinary Honours Master Programme “**East European Studies**”, and is for a fixed term of four years beginning October 1st 2005. The Chair will be held in both the Faculty of Social Sciences and the Faculty of Economics.

The responsibilities of the Chair include teaching and examining in the Faculties of Economics and Social Sciences in the context of the Elite Study Programme “East European Studies”.

It is expected that the successful candidate will have qualifications in both Economics and Political Science, and will be able to offer courses in both faculties. It is desirable that he or she has a specialised interest in Eastern Europe in relation to European integration and/or the political economy of transformation countries.

It might be possible that the Programme will be extended for a further 5 years.

Necessary qualifications are a university degree, proven competence in teaching, a PhD and Habilitation or equivalent academic qualifications. The successful candidate is expected to have published extensively in international journals.

At the time of appointment the candidate may not have passed his or her 52nd birthday. In extremely special circumstances however an exception could be made.

The University of Munich is committed to increasing the proportion of women in its academic positions and encourages suitably qualified women to apply.

Disabled persons will be given preference when qualifications for the position are equal to those of the other candidates.

Applications, together with the usual documents (curriculum vitae, degree certificates, list of publications) should be sent not later than January 24th 2005 to the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Economics, Room 402, Schackstrasse 4, 80539 Munich, Germany.
